

Observational Practicum Requirements. (Codes in STAG 7515, 7416 and 7414)

Course Description:

Teachers' interaction with learners in the modern language classroom is a critical aspect of teaching competence. This course aims to deepen your understanding of classroom interaction and enhance your classroom management skills. Key areas of focus may include: encouraging learner participation, managing classroom dynamics, incorporating various interaction patterns into lessons, and selecting and using resources appropriately.

Aim: You are required to observe classes with a focus on classroom management and prepare activities for a lesson.

Logistics:

- You will work in pairs.
- Agree, with the teacher in what class you will do tandem teaching
- Observe at least three lessons in the same class and fill in the observation sheet .(Please see the handout with the observation sheet.)
- Design a lesson plan with your peer. Select and include activities relevant for the class. Activities may be focused on practicing/proceduralising grammar issues, revising and consolidating (production activities and games) lexical material. Activities should be relevant for the group of learners, and be in tune with the current topic the teacher is covering.

In order to better know the school, please, learn from the teacher the following things or find them on the school official site:

- foreign languages taught at school;
- linguistic and cultural diversity of learners and teachers in school;
- participation in national and international projects, exchange with other schools or institutions, etc.

By January 6 submit:

- 4 observation forms
- A lesson plan with a detailed description of procedures, supplemented by the materials you used (use the given lesson plan format)
